



# CCC Small Group Guidelines

Community Christian Church is excited to allow small group Bible studies and meetings to meet on campus. The following guidelines are meant to keep our people and facility safe.

Please do not attend CCC Small Group Meetings if you:

- Were exposed to Covid-19 in the past 14 days
- Are at increased risk of Covid-19 complications due to age or medical reasons.
- Have a family member with increased risk of Covid-19 complications.
- Have experienced fever, chills, cough, headache, and other significant respiratory issues in the past 2 weeks.
- Have traveled out of the United States or have traveled by cruise ship or airplane in the past 14 days.

## Small Group Guidelines as of September 28, 2020:

- Masks are encouraged and will be utilized by CCC staff. Masks are available in the foyer.
- Members of households may sit together in small group meetings.
- Please abide by social distancing standards: spread out across tables and in meeting rooms. No more than 3 people to a table and chairs spaced 6' apart from each other.
- The nursery and children's wing are not available. The playground may be used with adult supervision.
- Each group meeting must have a designated group leader who will take responsibility for sanitizing tables and door knobs before and after your small group meeting. Supplies are available in the kitchen and/or foyer.
- The designated group leader will record attendance for each small group meeting and provide attendance to the church office. The church office will then be able to notify group members in the event that Covid-19 symptoms appear or exposure becomes known by a group member.
- If you experience Covid-19 symptoms or exposure becomes known, please contact the group leader and church office and provide as much detailed information as possible. The church office will notify all group attendees of the possibility of Covid-19 symptoms or exposure.
